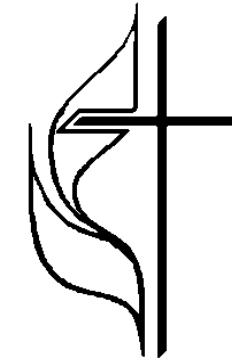
- **Mission U "Climate Justice: A Call to Hope and Action"**
