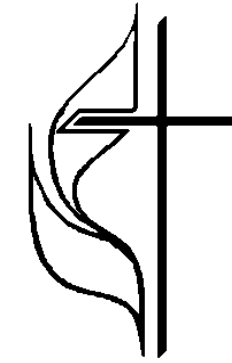
Youth Chili Bowl To Go and Plant Sale
