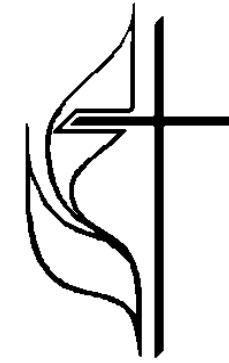
Part Time Children's Education Director
