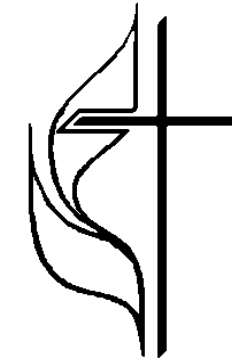
Altar Help Needed
