Vacation Bible School

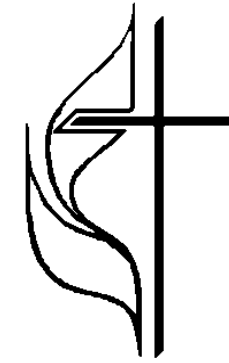
In-person VBS this summer June 27th to 30th from 9:00 am to Noon. Registration is now open at christumcutah.org/vbs.
