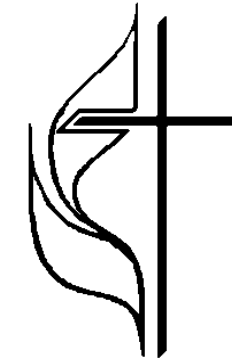
- **EV Chargers**
