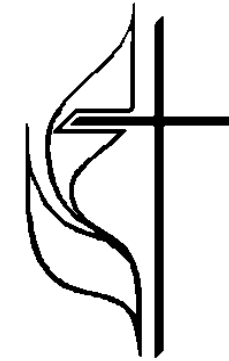
## News and Happenings
